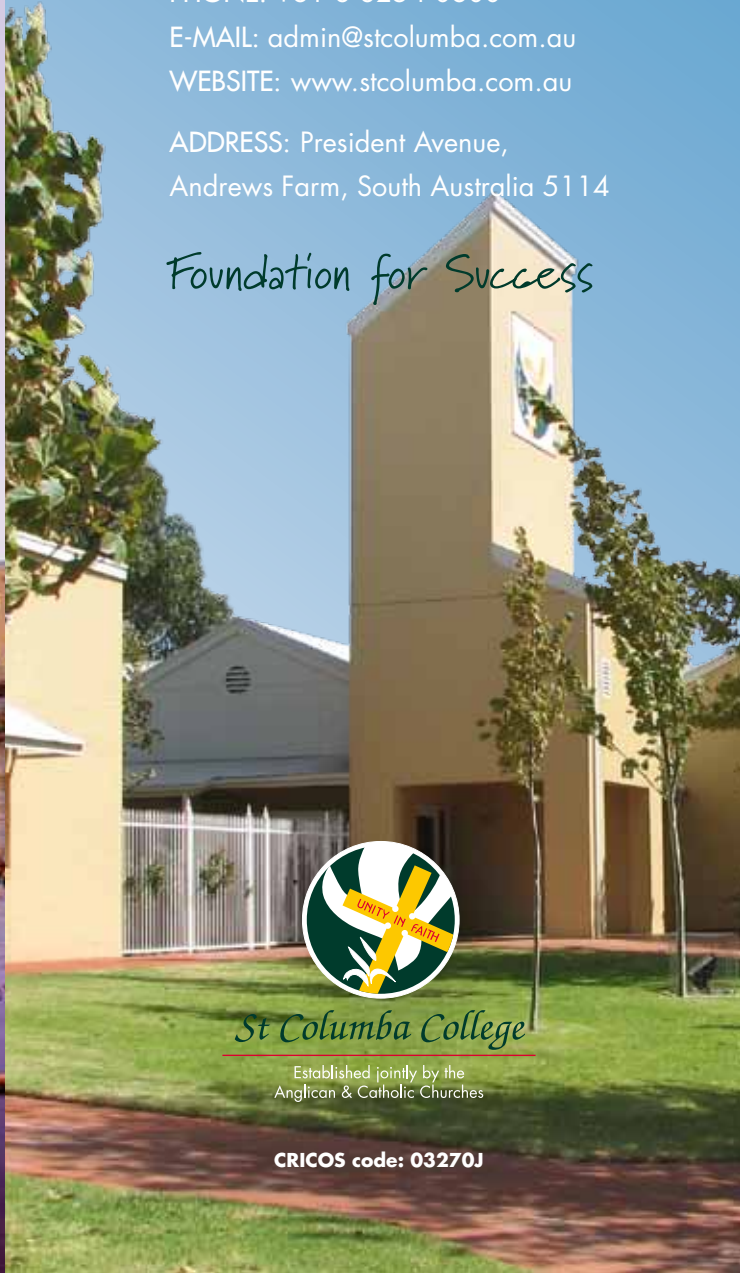

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## Every Student is Valued

St Columba College is Australia's first joint venture school, established in 1996 as an initiative of the Anglican and Catholic Archbishops of Adelaide.

The College, located in the beautiful outer Adelaide suburb of Andrews Farm, has three schools at President Avenue: a Primary School which hosts classes from Reception to Year 6, Middle School for students in Years 7 to 9 and a Senior School for Years 10 to 12.

Teaching at all levels in the College has a strong focus on developing skills in literacy and numeracy, thus providing a foundation for future success. The Senior School, offers a wide range of subjects and programs designed to educate students broadly, while being mindful of their future university ambitions or employment aspirations.

The College offers high quality, contemporary educational opportunities in an academic, creative and caring environment. At St Columba College every student is respected and valued.

## Dynamic Development

The College's environment has recently been enhanced with three new projects:

A state-of-the-art **Senior Science Centre**. This new Science facility enables our students to focus and concentrate on the rigors of Science as they prepare for SACE and University. The facility is a reflection of the College's commitment to academic excellence while encouraging students to seek employment pathways in the arena of science and technology.

A new **Gymnasium**, located on the Senior School site, is designed to enhance the College's Physical Education program while providing an after hours sporting and recreation centre.

A **Performing Arts Centre**, which encourages the development of individual student's creativity and group co-operation within the fields of Drama and Music.

In addition the College has implemented an innovative course in robotic studies and envisages in the future, a centre specialising in all aspects of the mechanics of robotics.

At St Columba College, our aim is to provide every student with an academic foundation that equips them for future success.

## Class Sizes

The College's current enrolment stands at approximately 1400 spread over three schools - Primary (550) Middle (450) and Senior (420). At the Senior level the average Home Class size is 20 students while subject class sizes are 15-25 students, depending on the interest in the subject.

## Year 12 Success

The percentage of Year 12 students who sat their SACE exams and achieved a Tertiary Entry Requirement (TER) Score were:

2008: **100%**      2009: **100%**      2010: **96%**

In 2010 the College DUX achieved an individual score of **99.25%**

## Fees

While St Columba College is one of the most progressive Colleges in South Australia with modern, state-of-the-art facilities, it prides itself on maintaining a fee structure that is affordable to all. For example; in 2011, an overseas senior (Year 10 - 12) full fee paying student's total tuition fee is \$14,472 (AUD).
